Grade 9

Driving Questions

Humanities → *How can I design a self-empowering high school experience that prepares me to “show-up” in school and life?*

STEAM → *How can our understanding of mycology support wellness for humanity and our earth?*

Learners continued their scientific inquiry via data collection of their agar inoculation to track its colonization.

Grade 10

Driving Question - *How can I use my 10th Grade experience at iADHS to help discover who I am and who I hope to become?*

Learners explored the history of the world from 200,000 BCE to today and studied the population trends over time. We also set goals for the passion project and put in the tools for the reveal in May.

International Issues - Globalization - Public Policy

This week we reconnected with our understanding of the **UN Sustainable Development Goals** by taking a focus on clean water and sanitation (goal 6). We traversed the globe with the waterschool initiative beginning with the Amazon then venturing into Austria. ‘Waterschool’ follows the experiences of several young female students who live along six of the world’s major rivers – the Amazon, Mississippi, Danube, Nile, Ganges and Yangtze – and celebrates the efforts of Waterschool. The documentary was born from the hearts and minds of seven UCLA School of Theater, Film and Television graduate students which led this crew across five continents to capture the moving stories of these young girls, giving voice to the generation for whom the preservation of clean water is most pressing. The exploration is a reminder of the power of education – with the support of the business community – *to transform lives and tackle the world’s pressing environmental issues.*

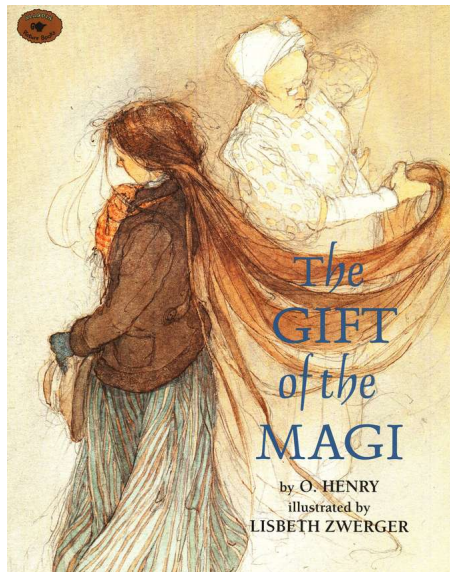

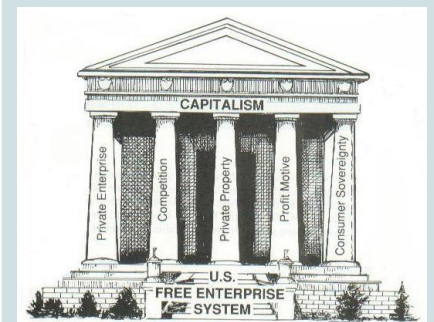
