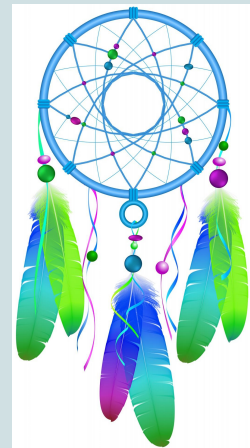
10th Grade: Hang just found her brother in Butterfly Yellow! However, is the reunion what she dreamed it would be? Ask your learners!

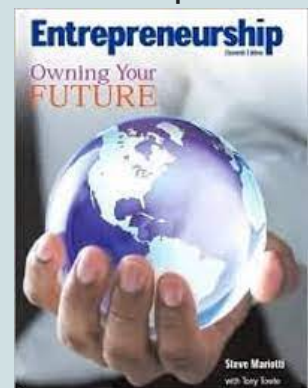
Learners watched a documentary on Enron and corporate ethics. We are reviewing how corporations use vision and mission statements to align with ethical practices and market their company to gain consumer trust. Upcoming, learners will be researching philanthropy and environmental best business practices. All learners are required to complete assignments using business applications and software when required to start gaining skills in these commonly used programs.

Professional Portfolios have also been initiated including a business/professional vocabulary log using a spreadsheet application. Learners also explored skills and did self-assessments to identify skills that can be included on resumes. Additional contributions to the professional portfolio will come from unit assignments and specialized lessons. Resources from the discussions have been posted in Brightspace for any learners absent.

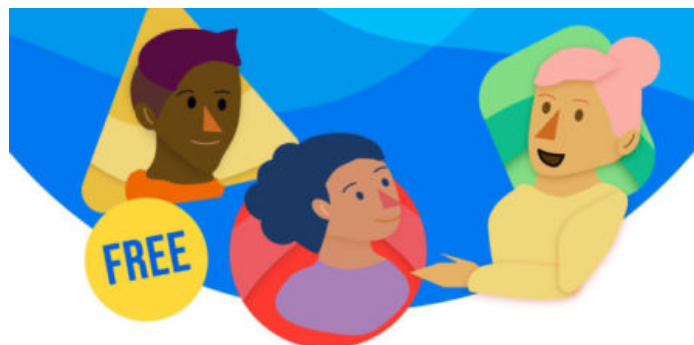
